ELEGANT WEDDING SHOWS – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Participation

- 1.1 The Exhibitor agrees to lease the space marked XXX on the attached plan for the sum of \$XXXX on the following terms.

2. Site Placement

- 2.1 Consideration will be given to the exhibitors' needs however final booth placement is at the discretion of EWS. Placing advertising materials or equipment, or soliciting in the aisles or any area other than the space allotted is strictly forbidden.
- 2.2 No exhibitor shall obstruct aisles, common areas, or neutral space between the booths with his/her goods or in any other manner.

3. Backdrops

- 3.1 EWS must be notified of the use of special backdrops 30 days prior to the show. All special backdrops shall be submitted to EWS 30 days prior to the show for EWS's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

4. Height Limit

- 4.1 Any exhibit over 2.3 meters high must have prior written approval by EWS.

5. Set-up and Breakdown:

- 5.1 Your booth must be completed half an hour prior to the show opening,

6. Forfeiture of Space

- 6.1 In the event a Licensee does not have their booth completed 30 minutes prior to the show opening EWS reserves the right in their sole and absolute discretion to re-allocate exhibit space not occupied by this time.
- 6.2 In that case monies paid to EWS for that expo will be forfeited.
- 6.3 All exhibits must be taken down within 4 hours following the close of the show.

7. Transfer of Space:

- 7.1 Your booth is solely for your use and may not be subleased, licensed or occupied by any other person, entity or individual.

8. Liability

- 8.1 EWS is not responsible for any liability/damage connected with the acceptance or the use of any exhibitor/licensee by any person(s) choosing their product or service.
- 8.2 The exhibitor/Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless EWS, the show, its producer, management, expo site, agents and employees from any and all claims, causes of action, and suits arising out of or resulting from any damage, injury, or loss to any persons, including, but not limited to persons to whom the exhibitor may be liable under New Zealand Law and exhibitor/Licensee him/herself, and from any loss, damage, cause of action, claims or suits from damages, including, but not limited to loss of property, goods, wares, or merchandise, caused by, arising out of, or in any way connected with the exercise by the exhibitor/Licensee of privileges granted herein.

- 8.3 The Exhibitor/Licensee should take steps necessary to insure himself/herself against any such loss, and if requested, exhibitor will provide proof of business liability insurance. In any policy of insurance obtained by exhibitor regarding this show, exhibitor shall name EWS as an additional insured.
- 8.4 Exhibitor will make good any damage to the building or fixtures caused by exhibitor or any of the exhibitors' agents or employees.
- 8.5 Exhibitors are responsible for any loss of their equipment and/or display material resulting from accidental breakage, misplacement, theft, fire, or natural disaster.

9. Cancellation by Exhibitor:

- 9.1 All cancellation requests must be made in writing prior to the show. If a cancellation is necessary within 60 days of the show, the booth fee is non-refundable and any remaining balance is still owed and collectible by EWS. If a cancellation is made prior to this time all monies paid will be refunded less your booking fee which is non-refundable and non transferable.

10. General

- 10.1 Should any questions arise, whether provided for in these conditions or not, the decision of EWS shall be final.

11. Force Majeure

- 11.1 In the event that either party is unable wholly or in part by force majeure to carry out its obligations to the other, and upon the defaulting party giving notice of particulars of such force majeure in writing to the other party as soon as possible after the occurrence of the cause relied upon, then the obligations of the defaulting party, so far as they are affected by such force majeure, shall be suspended during the continuance of any inability to supply and such cause shall, so far as possible, be remedied with all reasonable despatch.
